

General Introduction of Hong Kong CU Movement Charity Fund

Background

Hong Kong CU Movement Charity Fund is an officially authorized charity organization registered under Company Law, Hong Kong SAR Ordinance Cap. 32, on 22 September 2010 by the Credit Union League of Hong Kong.

Credit Union is a recognized cooperative organisation formed and owned by a group of people with common bonding. The objective of Credit Union is “not for profit, not for charity, but to serve”. By applying the “Self-help and Mutual-help” philosophy, Credit Union encourages members to save regularly and use the accumulated savings in helping members to improve their living standard, in the form of low interest loans.

Credit Union Movement in Hong Kong has a history of 50 years. It is being regulated and protected by “Credit Union Ordinance”, Hong Kong SAR Ordinance Cap 119. As at 31st December 2014, there were a total of 40 Credit Unions, with over 80,000 members in Hong Kong.

Credit Union League of Hong Kong is the top layer organization of the Credit Union Movement in Hong Kong. In an attempt to promote and encourage Credit Unions to fulfill their social responsibilities through a more effective and efficient channel, the Hong Kong CU Movement Charity Fund was established.

Objective

The prime objective of the Fund is to help the less fortunate group getting out of poverty by applying the "Self-help and Mutual-help" philosophy through well planned charity programmes. We target our work to cover Hong Kong, Mainland China and overseas. We welcome donations and assistance of any form.

Organization Structure

The Hong Kong CU Movement Charity Fund is a subsidiary of the Credit Union League of Hong Kong of which its directors are appointed by the Board of Credit Union League of Hong Kong.

The Board of this Charity Fund has a maximum of 15 members, work on a voluntary basis. It consists of one Chairman, two Vice Chairmen, one Treasurer and one Secretary plus a maximum of ten directors.

With the discretion of the Board, Hong Kong CU Movement Charity Fund may confer the following honorary title to individual or organization makes significant contribution to the fund.

Experience

From May 2007 to June 2008, rebuilt and upgraded Longjie Cengao Primary School in China as part of a partnership programme with Central 1 Credit Union of Canada.



From July 2009 to June 2010, running a “Pilot Youth Community Inclusion Programme” together with Ngau Tau Kok Caritas Community Centre. Funding was mainly from the Government, Labour and Welfare Bureau ‘Community Investment and Inclusion Fund’.



Since 2010, a grant-in-aid scheme named “Project Hope Class” was organized in Mainland China, targeting to finance those poor students with good conduct and academic results to complete their high school studies. We are currently operating this programme at Longchuan County, Heyuan City, Guangdong Province. “Project Hope Class” is an on-going programme. By far, 300 students have benefitted through this programme.



Starting from October 2012, a “Placement and Scholarship on Micro Finance Studies” was offered to university students in Hong Kong. Its objective is to maintain sustainability of Credit Union Movement in Hong Kong. A total of 34 students were accepted to join this scheme in academic year 2014/15.



Voluntary team and other charity programmes

In conjunction with other Charity Organizations, Hong Kong CU Movement Charity Fund conducts a widely accepted programme named “Shoot With Love”. Its objective is to demonstrate care and love for the less fortunate group in the community.

Project Introduction

The Hong Kong CU Movement Charity Fund is currently running the “Project Hope Class” in Mainland China. We are now raising funds to help poor students with good academic results to complete their 3 years high school studies so that they can have opportunities for further education. It is a 3-year term project with an annual amount of RMB 3,000 or HK\$4,000*, a total of RMB 9,000 or HK\$12,000* for one student. We welcome one-off payment, by installment or partial donation.
