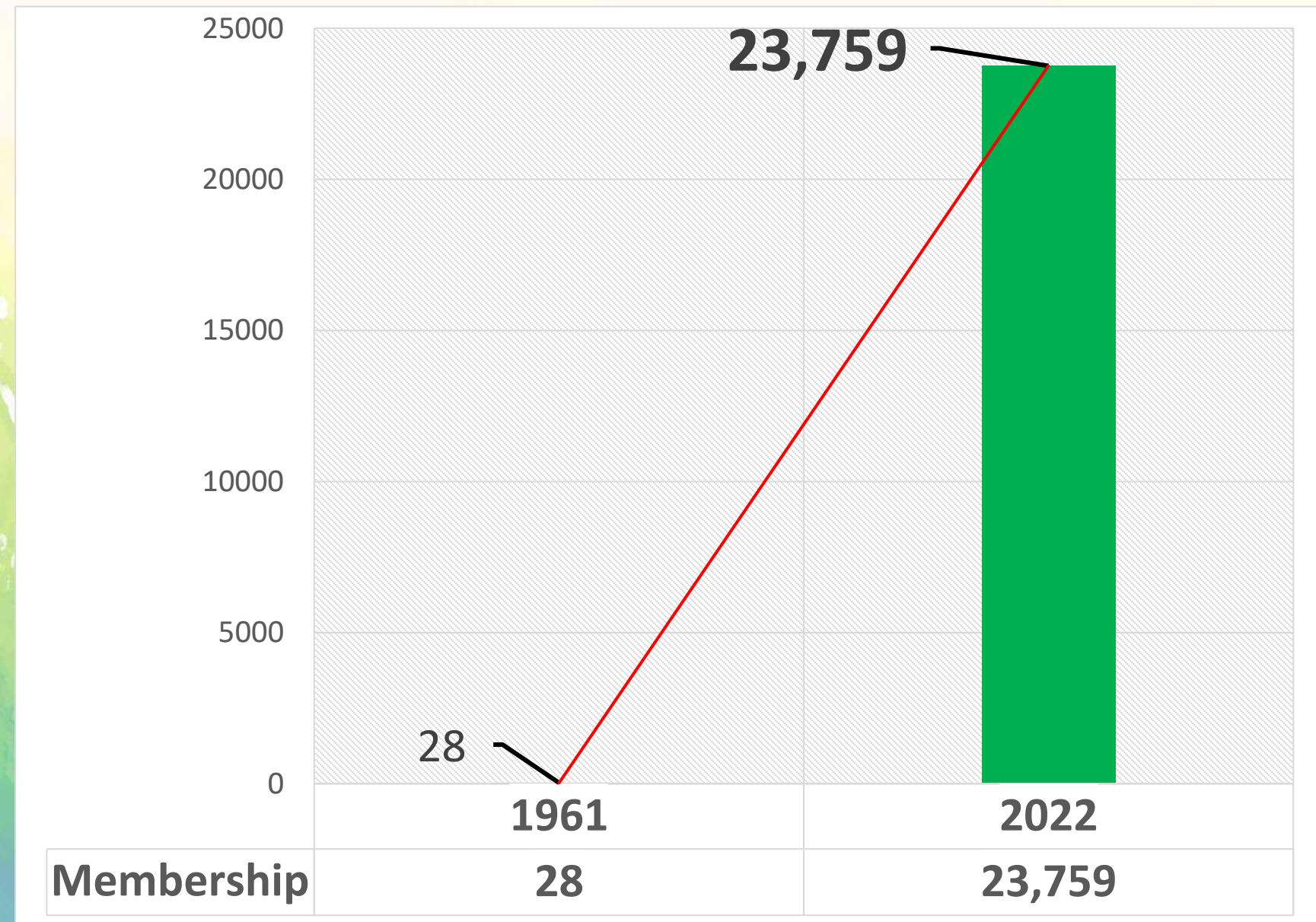
History of San Dionisio Credit Cooperative



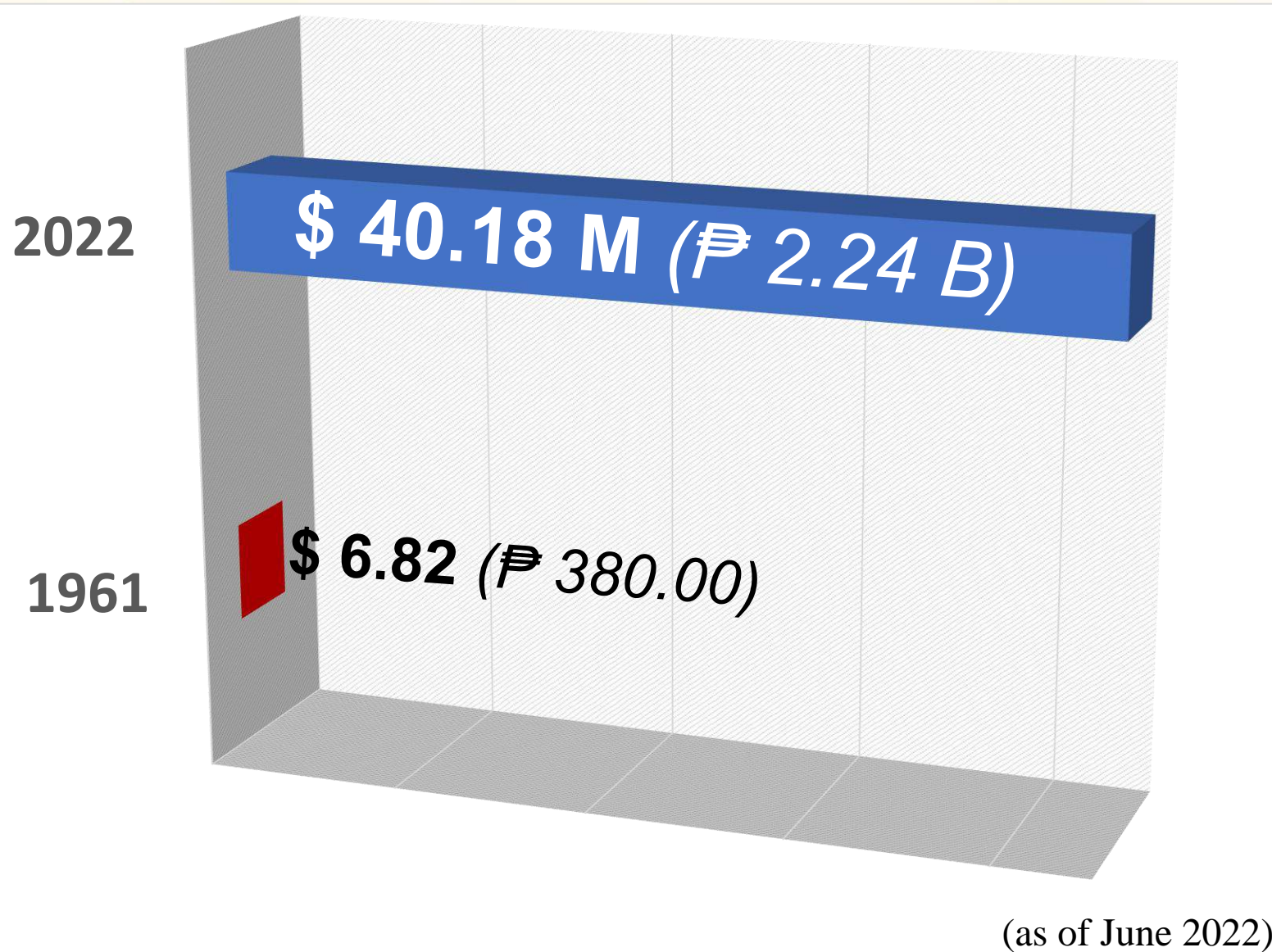
- San Dionisio Cooperative Credit Union, Inc. (SDCCUI)
- Founded July 28, 1961
- Twenty-eight (28) founding members, inspired and assisted by:
 - Rover Scouts
 - Jesuit priests
 - Fr. Walter Hogan and Fr. Gaston Duscheneau from Institute of Social Order (ISO)

- February 21, 1975 (Re-registration)

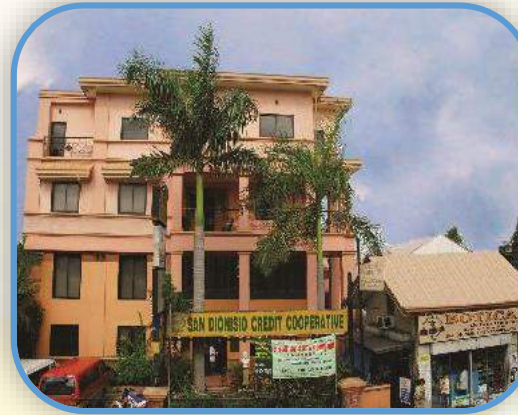

According to **Phivolcs**:

An 8.3 magnitude earthquake at the Manila Trench can trigger a tsunami in Manila Bay. Estimated wave height is 3.5 meters at mean sea level and 5.5 meters in a high tide. The tsunami waves can arrive in about an hour & can travel up to 2.7 kms away from the shoreline. Learn about your area's early warning signals & evacuation plan!

Parañaque City Ordinance No: 18-40 series of 2019

“An ordinance regulating the use, provision and sale of styrofoam, plastic bags and plastic for prepared food and beverage containers including plastic straws and stirrers in the City of Parañaque and prescribing penalties”

PENALTIES:

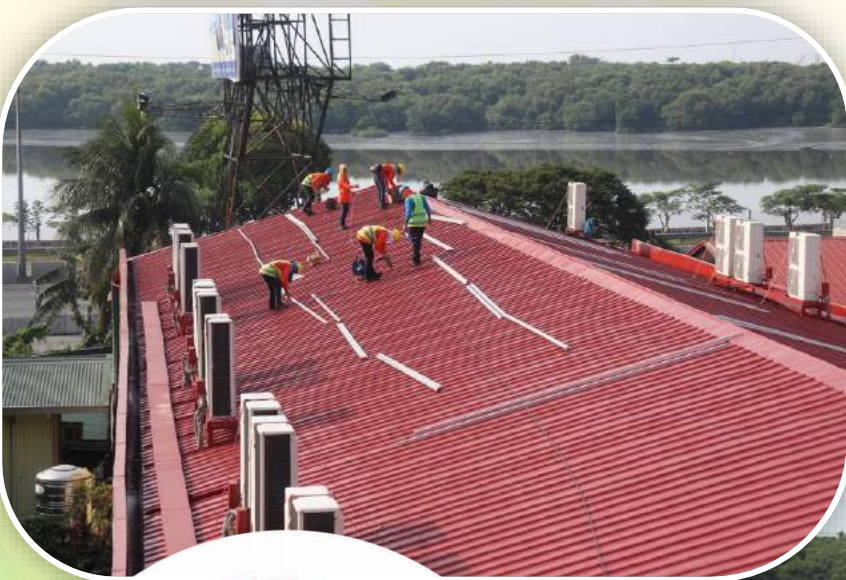
1st Offense : a fine of Five Thousand Pesos (Php 5,000.00)
2nd Offense : a fine of Five Thousand Pesos (Php 5,000.00)
3rd Offense : a fine of Five Thousand Pesos (Php 5,000.00)
and closure of the business establishment and cancellation of their business license to operate for a period of one (1) year

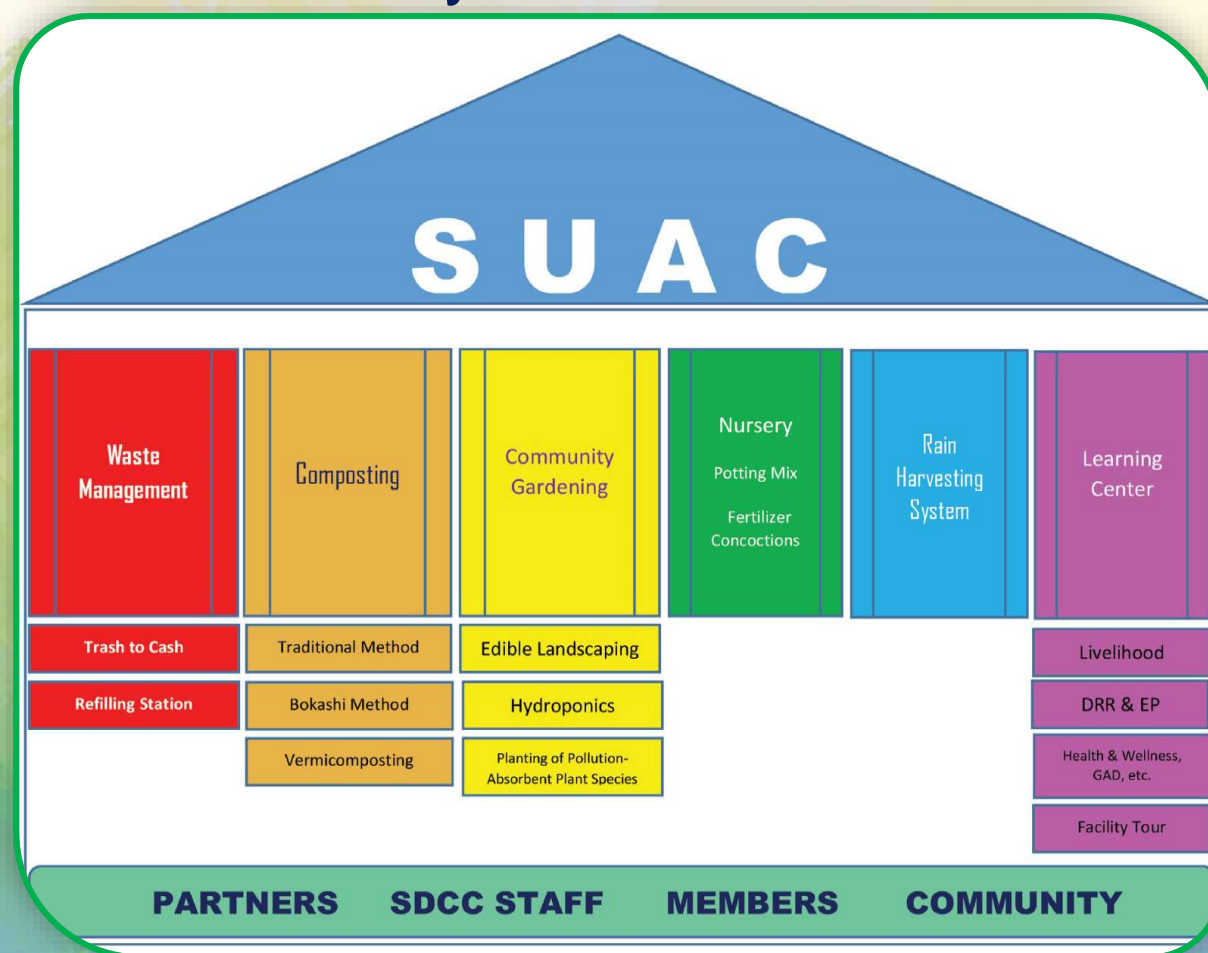

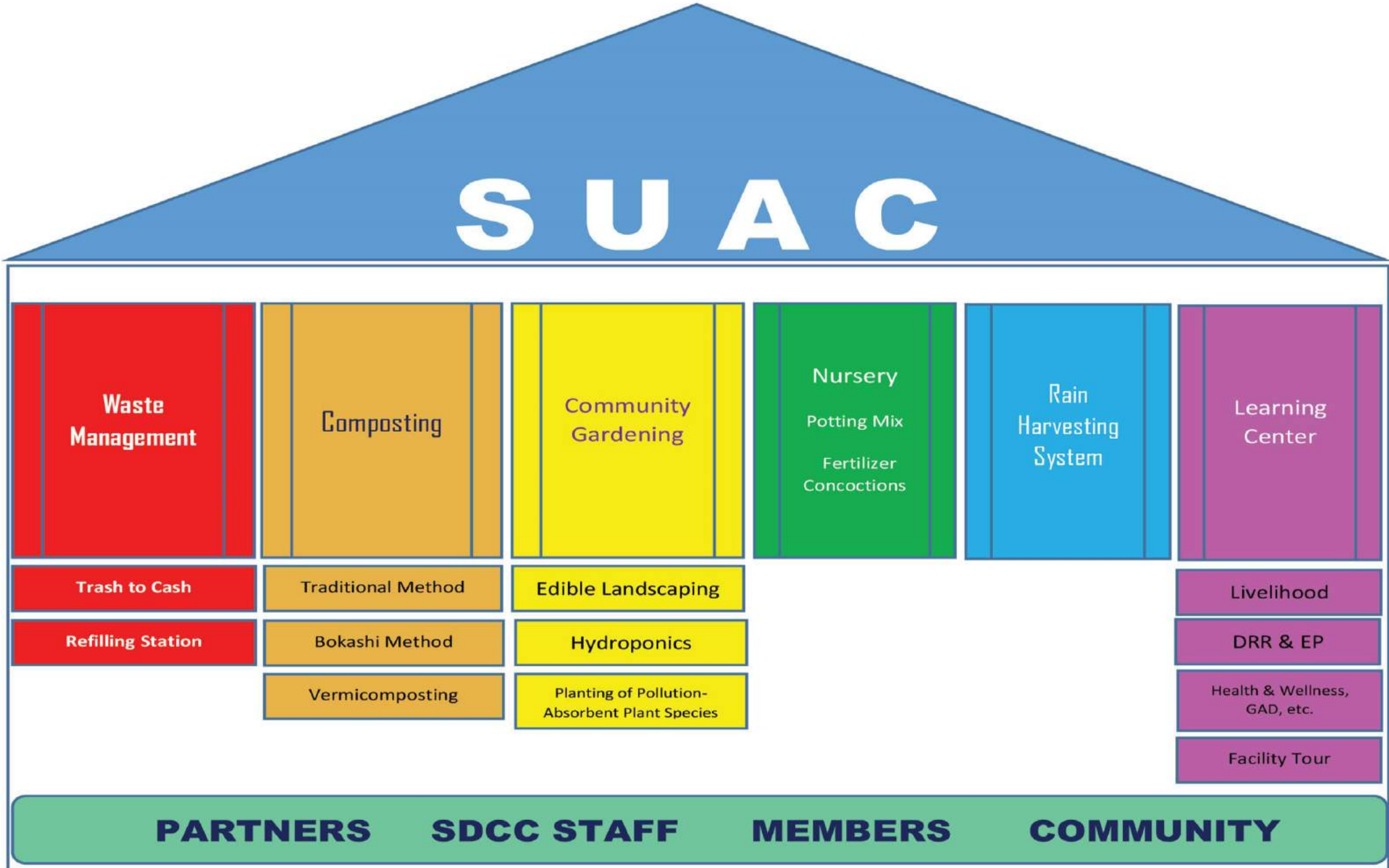
