CANCELLATION & TRANSFERS:

- If you cannot attend, a substitute delegate is welcome to participate in your place (same gender) at no additional charge provided you inform us on or before July 15, 2024.
- A full refund, less a 20% administrative charge, will be given if cancellation is received in writing on or before July 15, 2024.
- A 50% refund will be given if cancellation is received in writing at least seven working days (August 25) prior to the forum. Cancellations received less than seven days before the forum cannot be refunded.

The registration fee covers the following: accommodation in single or twin-sharing room, Meals from dinner on the day of arrival to breakfast on the day of departure, Conference materials, and credit union visits, conference kit, and credit union visit.
